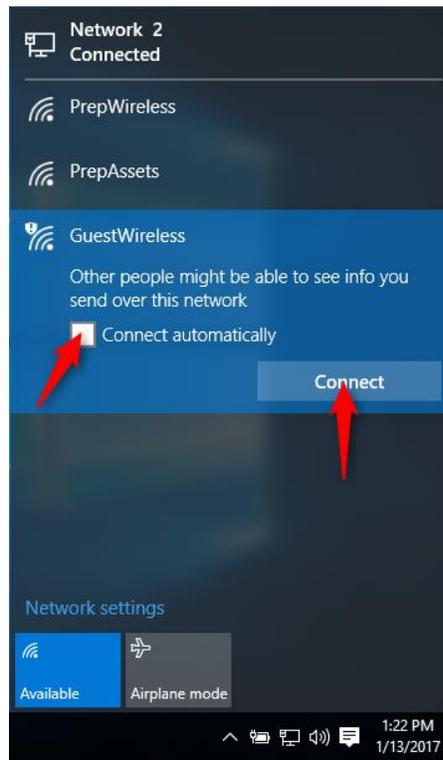
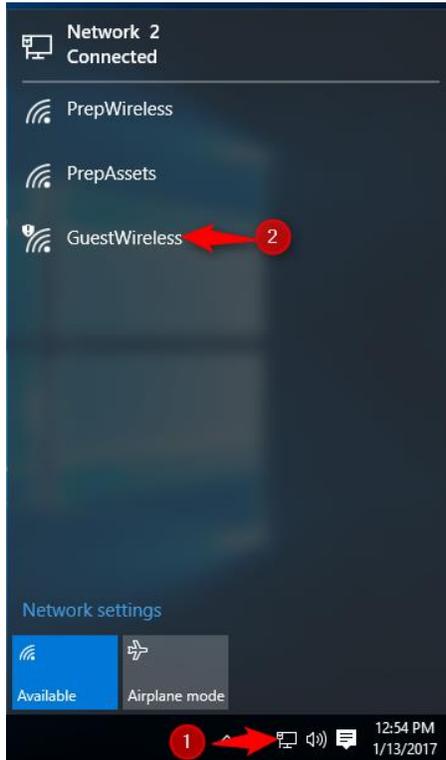


# St. Augustine Prep – GuestWireless Instructions

Step 1 – Click on the Monitor Icon in your taskbar. This will bring up all of the wireless connections available at St. Augustine Prep. You'll then want to choose GuestWireless. Next, put a check mark in "**Connect Automatically**" and then press "**Connect**"



Step 2 – Once connected to GuestWireless, open up your web browser ( Firefox or Chrome is the browser we suggest using ). You should be redirected to our Registration page. If you aren't automatically redirected, surf to any web page and it will redirect you to the Registration page. Choose **Self Registration** and click **Start**



Step 3 – Fill out the form on this page. You'll need to enter your Email address, First name, Last name, Person Visiting, and the Reason for your visit. Then press **Request Guest Access**
